the whole **creation** has **been** groaning as in the pains of **childbirth** right up to the **present** time. Not only so, but we ourselves, who have the firstfruits of the **Spirit**, **groan** inwardly as we **wait** eagerly for our adoption to sonship, the redemption of our bodies. For in this **hope** we were saved. But **hope** that is seen is no **hope** at all. Who hopes for what they already have? But if we **hope** for what we do not yet have, we **wait** for it patiently. In the same way, the **Spirit** helps us in our weakness. We do not **know** what we ought to pray for, but the **Spirit** himself **intercedes** for us through wordless groans. And he who searches our hearts knows the mind of the **Spirit**, because the **Spirit intercedes** for God's people in accordance with the will of God. And we **know** that in all things God works for the good of those who love him, who have **been called according** to his purpose. For those God foreknew he **also predestined** to be conformed to the image of his Son, that he might be the firstborn among many brothers and sisters. And those he **predestined**, he **also called**; those he **called**, he **also justified**; those he **justified**, he **also** glorified.
