Since we have now **been justified** by his blood, how **much more** shall we be **saved** from God's wrath through him! For if, while we were God's enemies, we were **reconciled** to him through the death of his Son, how **much more**, having **been reconciled**, shall we be **saved** through his life! Not **only** is this so, but we **also boast** in God through our **Lord Jesus Christ**, through whom we have now received reconciliation. abide Romans 5:1-11
