




them by giving the Holy Spirit to them, just as he did to us. He did not discriminate between us and them, for he purified their hearts by faith. Now then, why do you try to test God by putting on the necks of **Gentiles** a yoke that neither we nor our ancestors have been able to **bear**? No! We **believe** it is through the grace of our **Lord** Jesus that we are saved, just as they are." The whole assembly became silent as they listened to Barnabas and Paul telling about the signs and wonders God had done among the **Gentiles** through them. When they finished, James spoke up. "Brothers," he said, "listen to me. Simon has described to us how God first intervened to choose a people for his **name** from the **Gentiles**. The words of the prophets are in agreement with this, as it is written: "'After this I will return and **rebuild** David's fallen tent. Its ruins I will **rebuild**, and I will restore it, that the rest of mankind may seek the **Lord**, even all the **Gentiles** who **bear** my **name**, says the **Lord**, who does these **things'**— **things** known from long ago. "It is my judgment, therefore, that we should not make it difficult for the **Gentiles** who are turning to God. The letter listed some things for the believers to avoid.















Paul and Barnabas wanted to make sure that this error would not spread.


teaching with the <u>apostles</u> and <u>elders</u>. The Jerusalem church sent <u>Judas</u> and <u>Silas</u> back to Antioch with a <u>letter</u>. They told the <u>Gentile</u> Christians not to be troubled by what the <u>men</u> had <u>said</u>.



The church leaders wanted to be sure to teach the truth and not to confuse people or give them unnecessary rules.
