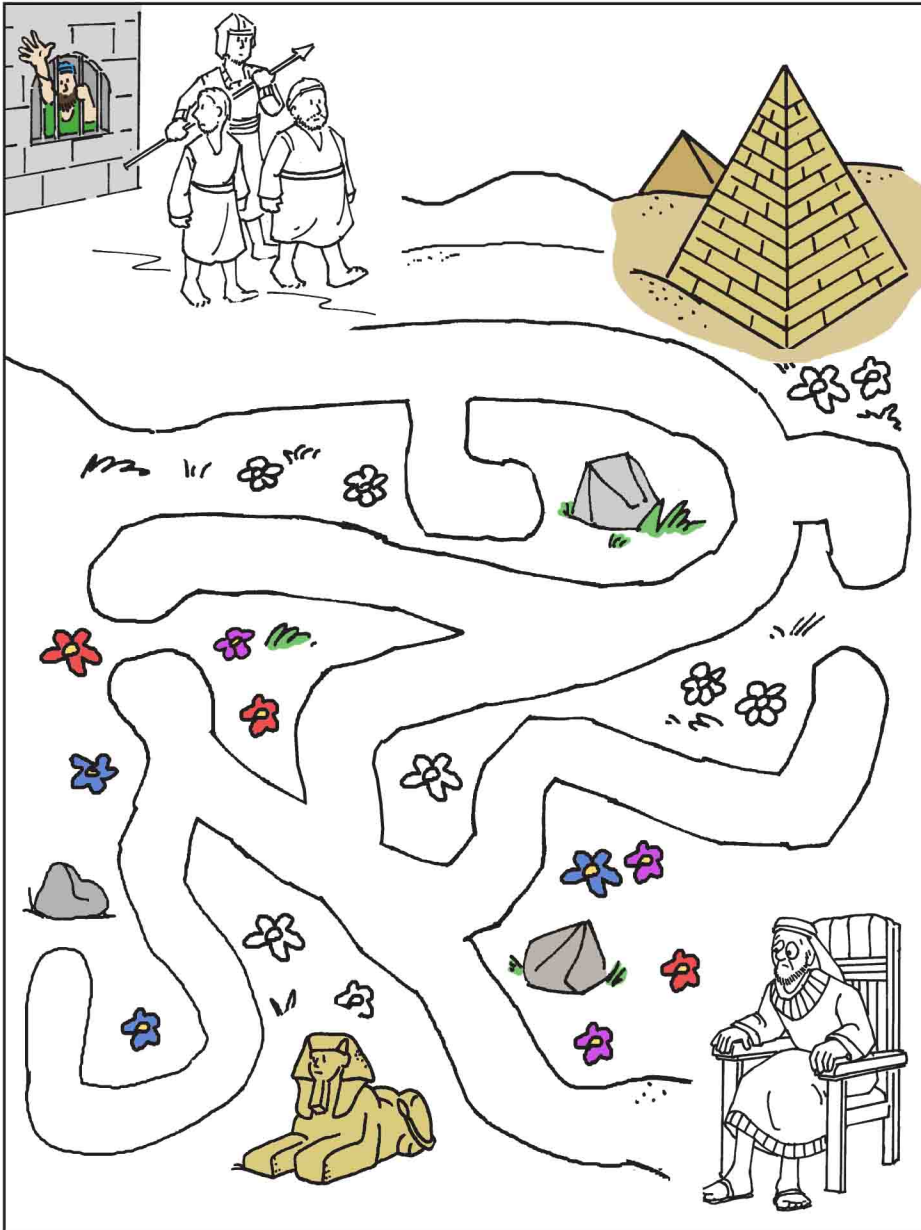

When his **master** saw that the **LORD** was with him and that the **LORD gave** him success in **everything** he did, **Joseph found favor** in his **eyes** and **became** his **attendant**. **Potiphar** put him in **charge** of his **household**, and he **entrusted** to his **care everything** he **owned**. From the time he put him in **charge** of his **household** and of all that he **owned**, the **LORD blessed** the **household** of the **Egyptian** because of **Joseph**. The blessing of the **LORD** was on **everything Potiphar** had, both in the **house** and in the field.

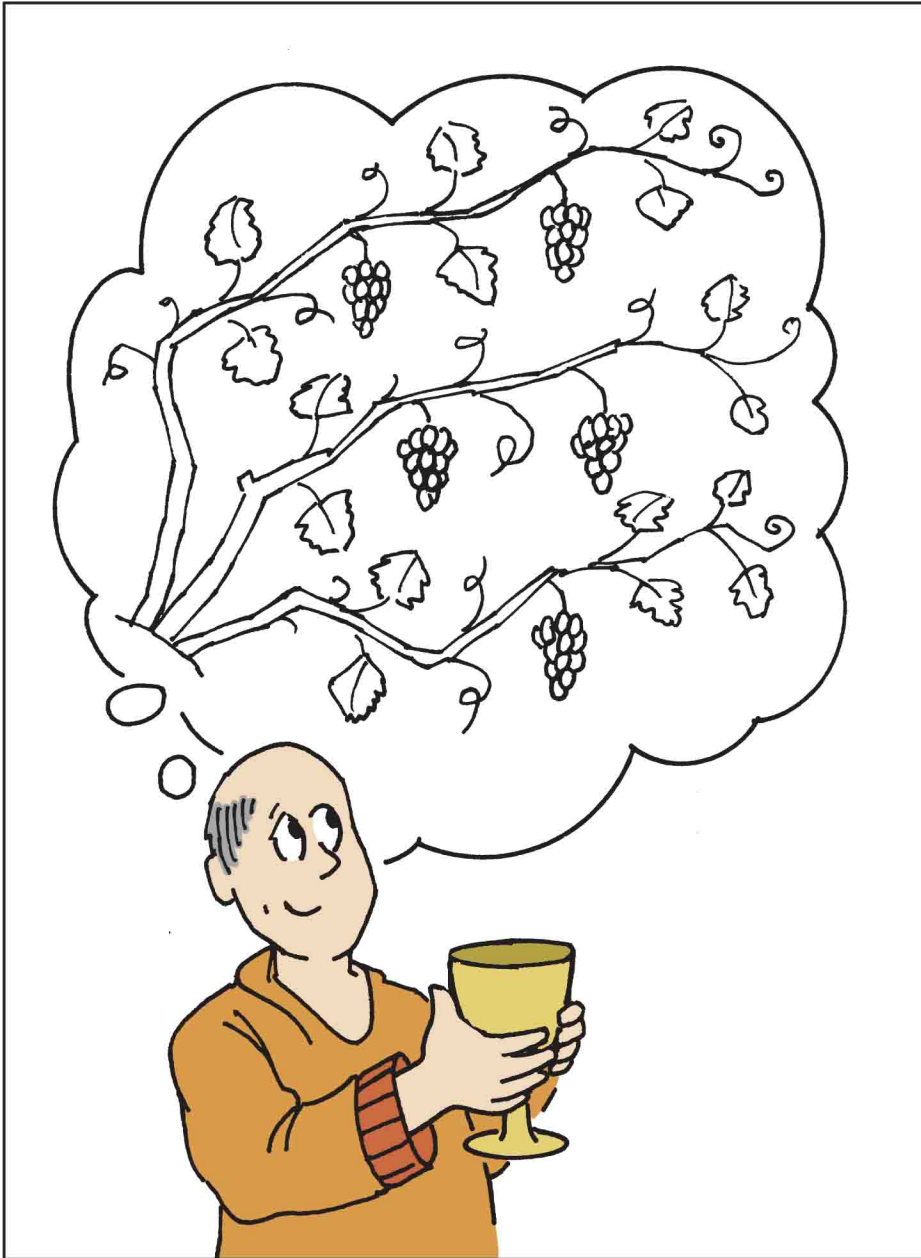

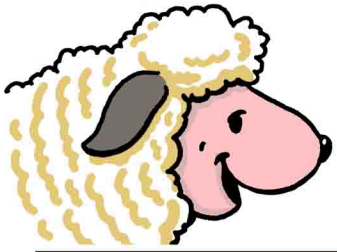


The second man was Pharaoh's baker. His dream

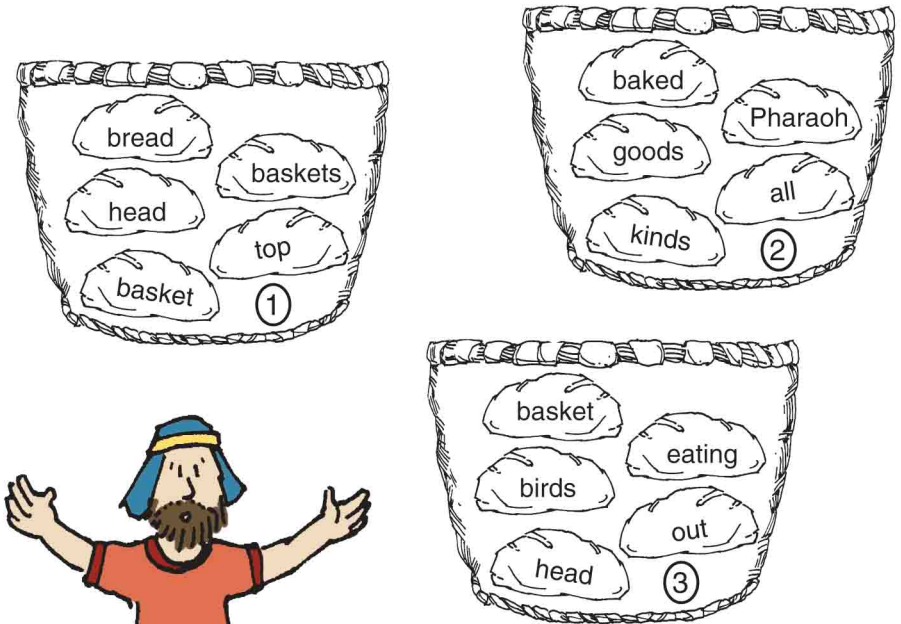
