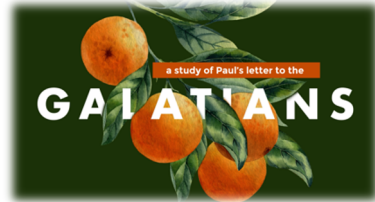

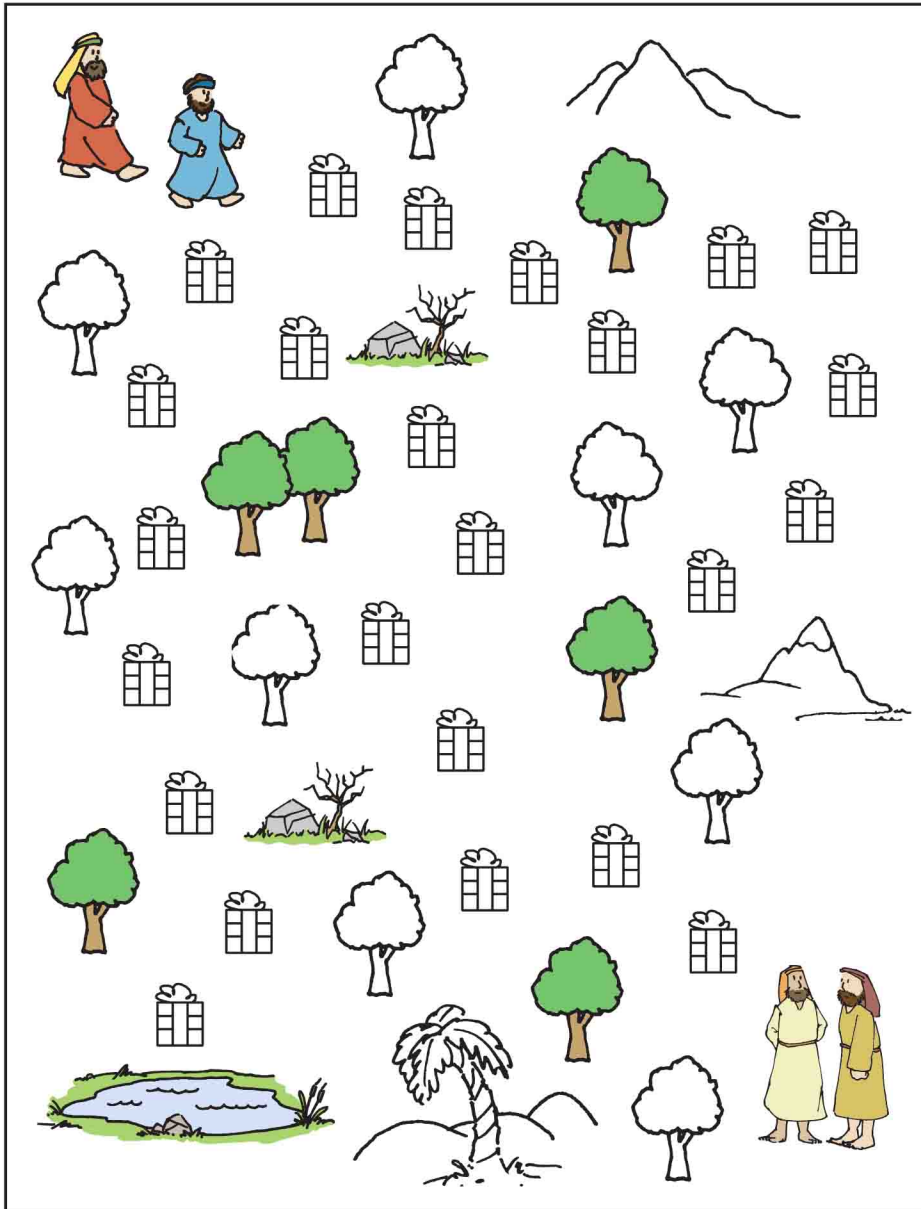

Then after **fourteen** years, I went up **again** to **Jerusalem**, this time with **Barnabas**. I took **Titus** along **also**. I went in **response** to a **revelation** and, **meeting** **privately** with those esteemed as **leaders**, I **presented** to them the **gospel** that I preach among the **Gentiles**. I wanted to be sure I was not **running** and

had not **been running** my **race** in vain. Yet not **even Titus**, who was with me, was compelled to be **circumcised**, **even** though he was a Greek. This matter arose because some false believers had infiltrated our ranks to spy on the freedom we have in Christ Jesus and to **make** us slaves. We did not give in to them for a moment, so that the truth of the **gospel** might be preserved for you. As for those who were held in high **esteem**—whatever they were makes no difference to me; God does not show favoritism—they added nothing to my message. On the contrary, they **recognized** that I had **been** entrusted with the task of preaching the **gospel** to the uncircumcised, just as **Peter** had **been** to the **circumcised**. For God, who was at **work** in **Peter** as an **apostle** to the **circumcised**, was **also** at **work** in me as an **apostle** to the **Gentiles**. James, Cephas and John, those esteemed as pillars, gave me and **Barnabas** the right hand of fellowship when they **recognized** the grace given to me. They agreed that we should go to the **Gentiles**, and they to the **circumcised**. All they asked was that we should continue to remember the poor, the very thing I had **been** eager to do all along.

When a famine was predicted many disciples sent gifts to help.

Follow the gift trail to get the gifts to Saul and Barnabus.



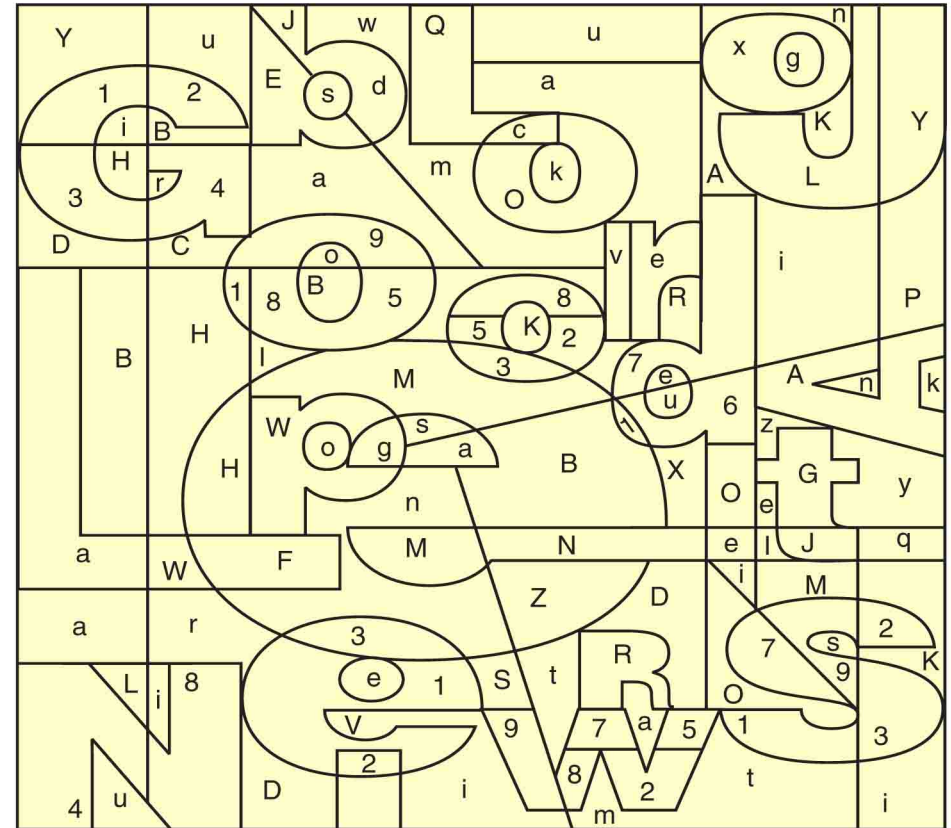

Jews and Greeks were hearing the ...

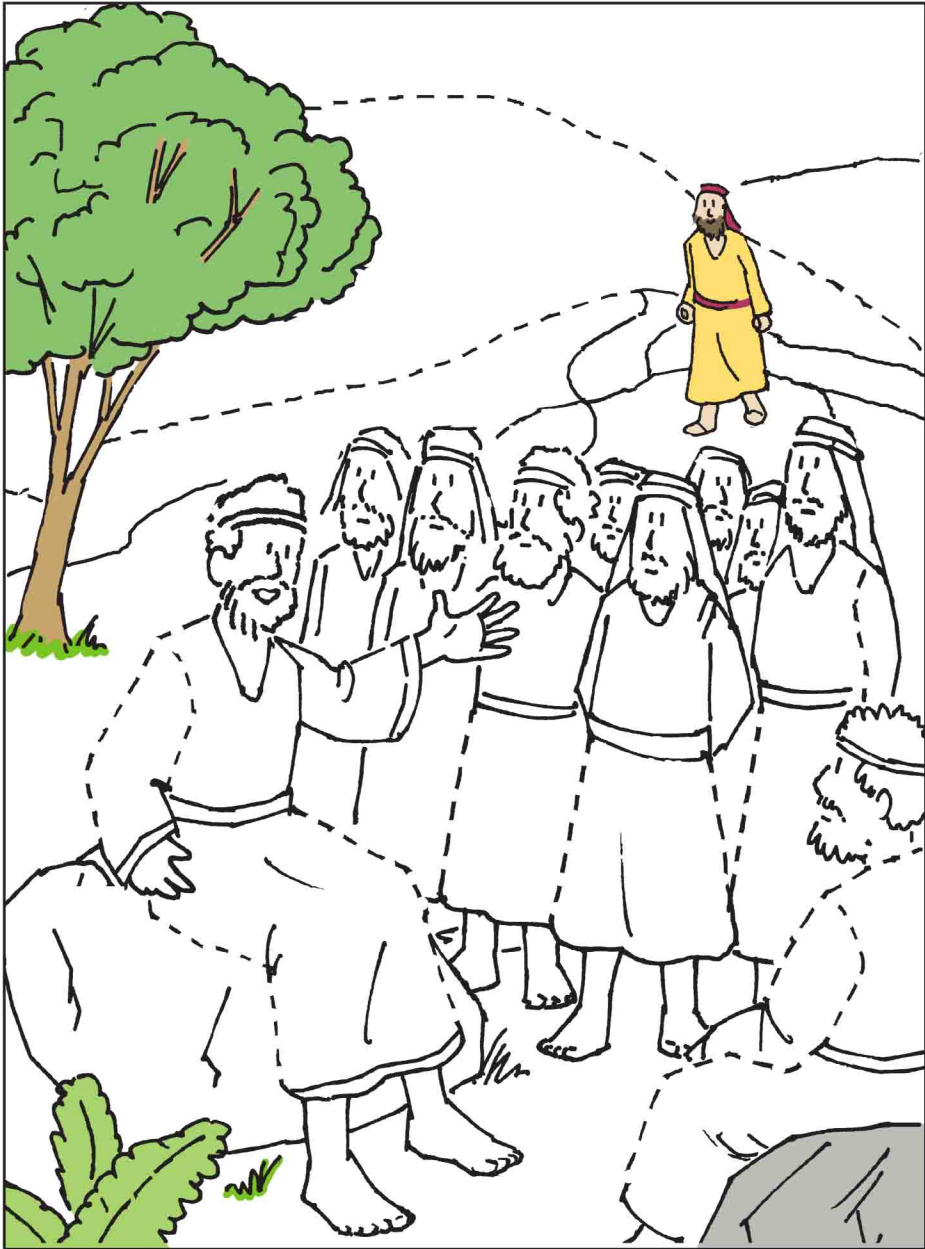
Shade in the shapes with numbers.



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Barnabas, then Saul, came to preach.

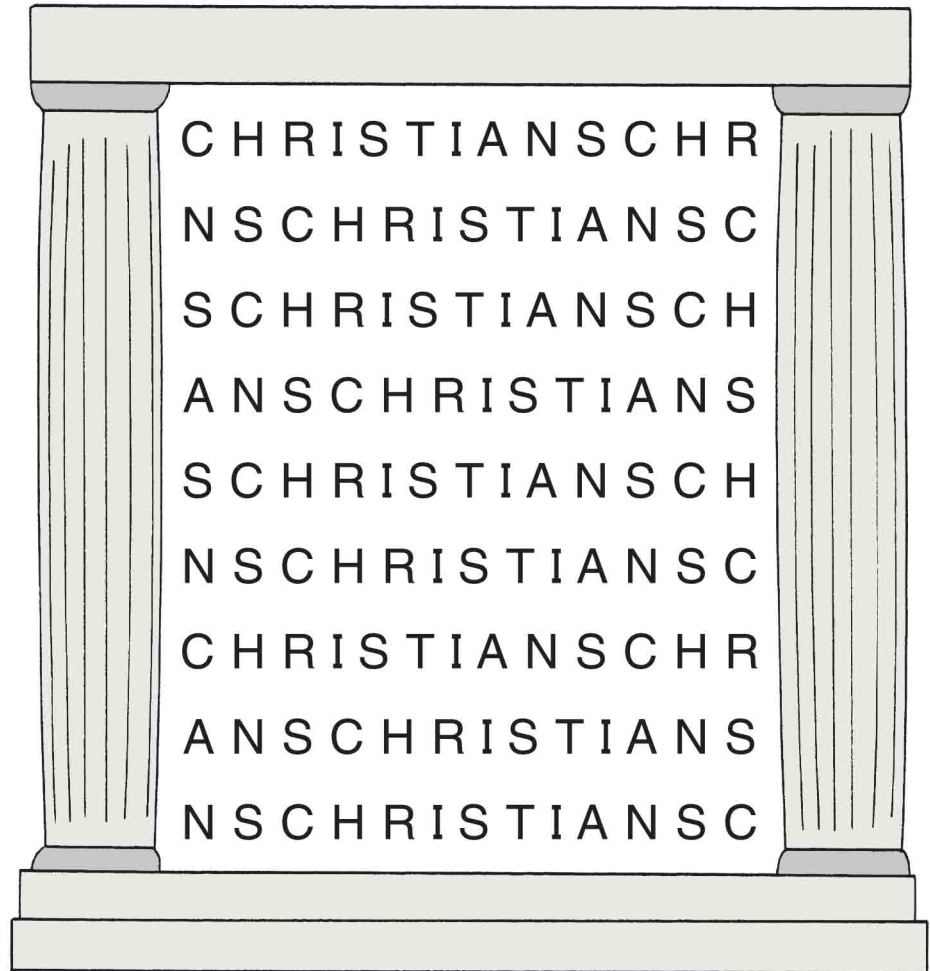

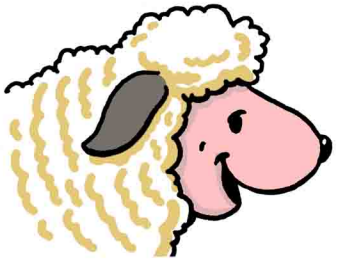


The church in Antioch grew. The believers there were the first to be called Christians.
