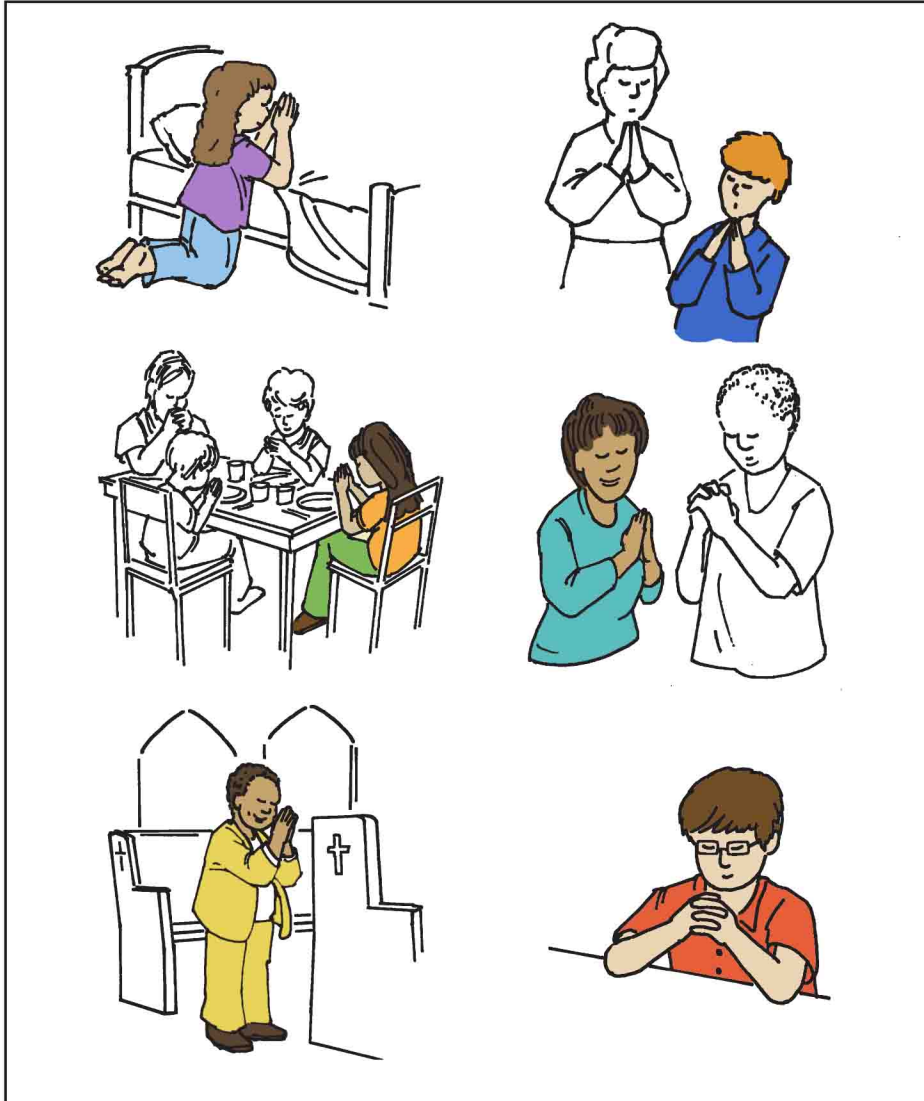

Scripture does
 not say "and to
 seeds," meaning
many people,
 but "and to your

seed," meaning one person, who is **Christ**. What I **mean** is this: The law, introduced 430 years later, does not set **aside** the **covenant** previously **established** by God and thus do away with the **promise**. For if the inheritance **depends** on the law, **then** it no longer **depends** on the **promise**; but God in his grace gave it to **Abraham** through a **promise**. Why, **then**, was the law **given** at all? It was added because of transgressions until the **Seed** to whom the **promise** referred had **come**. The law was **given** through angels and entrusted to a **mediator**. A **mediator**, however, implies more than one party; but God is one. Is the law, therefore, opposed to the promises of God? Absolutely not! For if a law had **been given** that could impart **life**, **then** righteousness would certainly have **come** by the law. But **Scripture** has locked up everything under the control of sin, so that what was promised, being **given** through faith in Jesus **Christ**, might be **given** to those who believe.

and hears our prayers.
