On the third day a wedding took place at Cana in Galilee. Jesus' mother was there. 2 and Jesus and his disciples had also been invited to the wedding. 3 When the wine was gone, Jesus' mother said to him. "They have no more wine." 4 "Woman, why do you involve me?" Jesus replied. "My hour has not yet come." 5 His mother said to the servants, "Do whatever he tells you." 6 Nearby stood six stone water jars, the kind used by the Jews for ceremonial washing, each holding from twenty to thirty gallons. ⁷ Jesus said to the servants, "Fill the jars with water": so they filled them to the brim. 8 Then he told them, "Now draw some out and take it to the master of the banquet." They did so, ⁹ and the master of the banquet tasted the water that had been turned into wine. He did not realize where it had come from, though the servants who had drawn the water knew. Then he called the bridegroom aside ¹⁰ and said, "Everyone brings out the choice wine first and then the cheaper wine after the guests have had too much to drink; but you have saved the best till now." 11 What Jesus did here in Cana of Galilee was the first of the signs through which he revealed his glory; and his disciples believed in him.

I just wanted to take a moment to thank you for the offering recently sent by Fellowship. We are so thankful for your continued support, even in the middle of the pandemic and financial difficulties that it has brought.

I must tell you that Fellowship CRC is an inspiration to us. As a church here in Tulancingo, we have been supporting a mobile Bible School in Uganda. We took on this mission project many years ago and were able to personally meet the brother who is in charge of the school during our time in Uganda in 2018. Even though our church's offerings have gone down quite a bit during past year because of the pandemic, we have made the decision to do even as you have done - to continue to support our missionaries in Uganda, even in the midst of lack here at home. We believe in missions and in our missionaries! We want to be like the Philippian church, which continued to support Paul, even when they themselves were lacking in finances.
