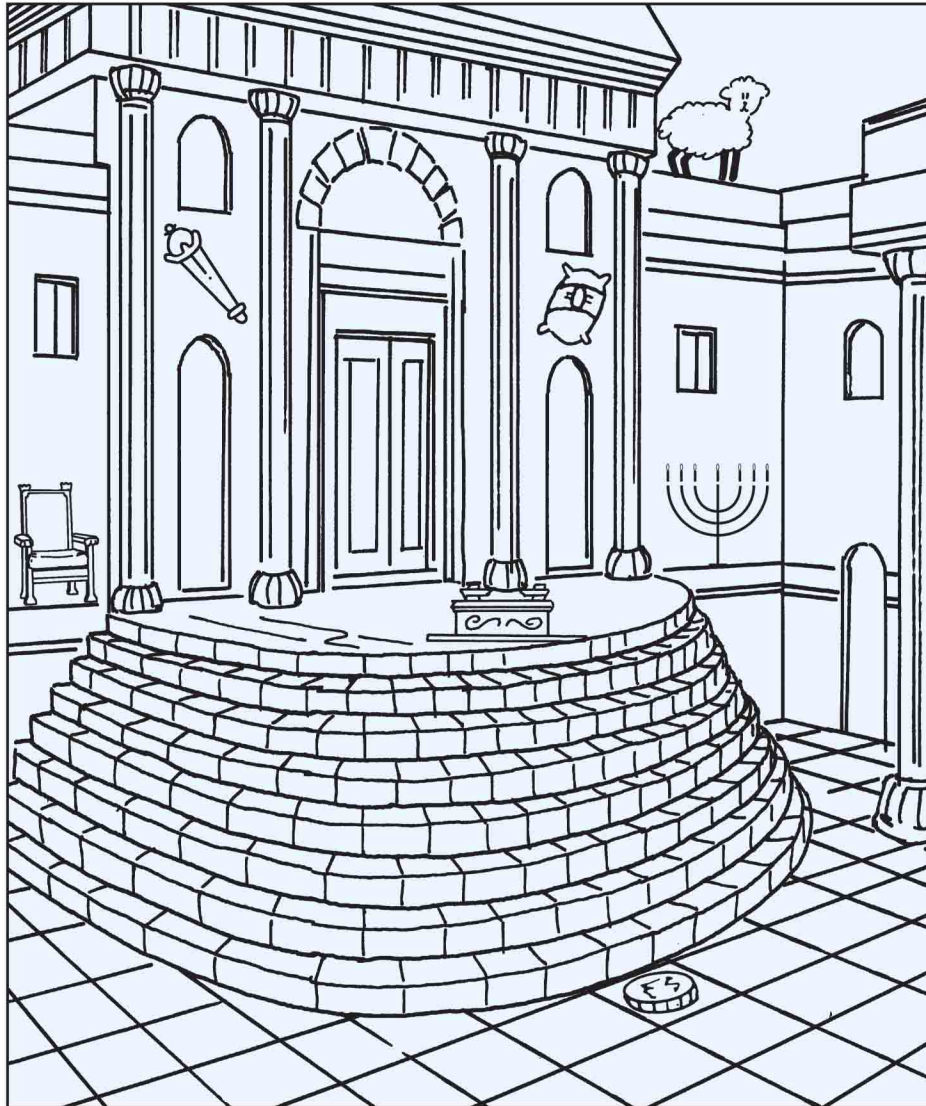
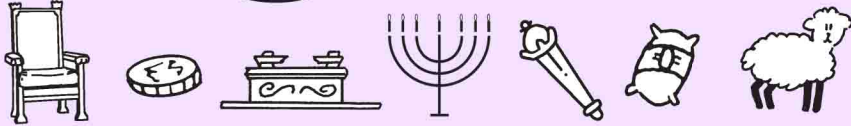

For the **sake** of the **house** of the **LORD** our God, I will seek your prosperity.

The psalm also says, "For the sake of the Lord's house, I will seek good for Jerusalem."
