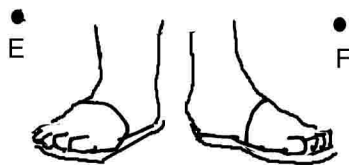
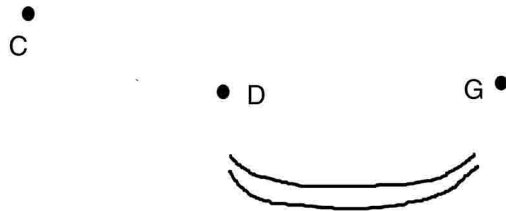

**When Elisha** the man of God **heard** that the **king of Israel** had **trn** his **robes**, he **sent** him this message: “Why have you **trn** your **robes**? Have the man **come** to me and he will know that there is a **prophet** in **Israel**.” So **Naaman went** with his **horses** and **chariots** and stopped at

the **door** of **Elisha’s house**. **Elisha sent** a messenger to say to him, “Go, **wash** yourself **seven times** in the **Jordan**, and your **flesh** will be **restored** and you will be **cleansed**.” But **Naaman went away angry** and **said**, “I thought that he would surely **come** out to me and stand and call on the name of the LORD his God, wave his hand over the spot and cure me of my leprosy. Are not Abana and Pharpar, the rivers of Damascus, better than all the waters of **Israel**? Couldn’t I **wash** in them and be **cleansed**?” So he turned and **went** off in a rage. **Naaman’s** servants **went** to him and **said**, “My father, if the **prophet** had **told** you to do some great thing, would you not have done it? How much more, then, **when** he tells you, ‘**Wash** and be **cleansed**!’” So he **went** down and dipped himself in the **Jordan seven times**, as the man of God had **told** him, and his **flesh** was **restored** and became clean like that of a young boy.

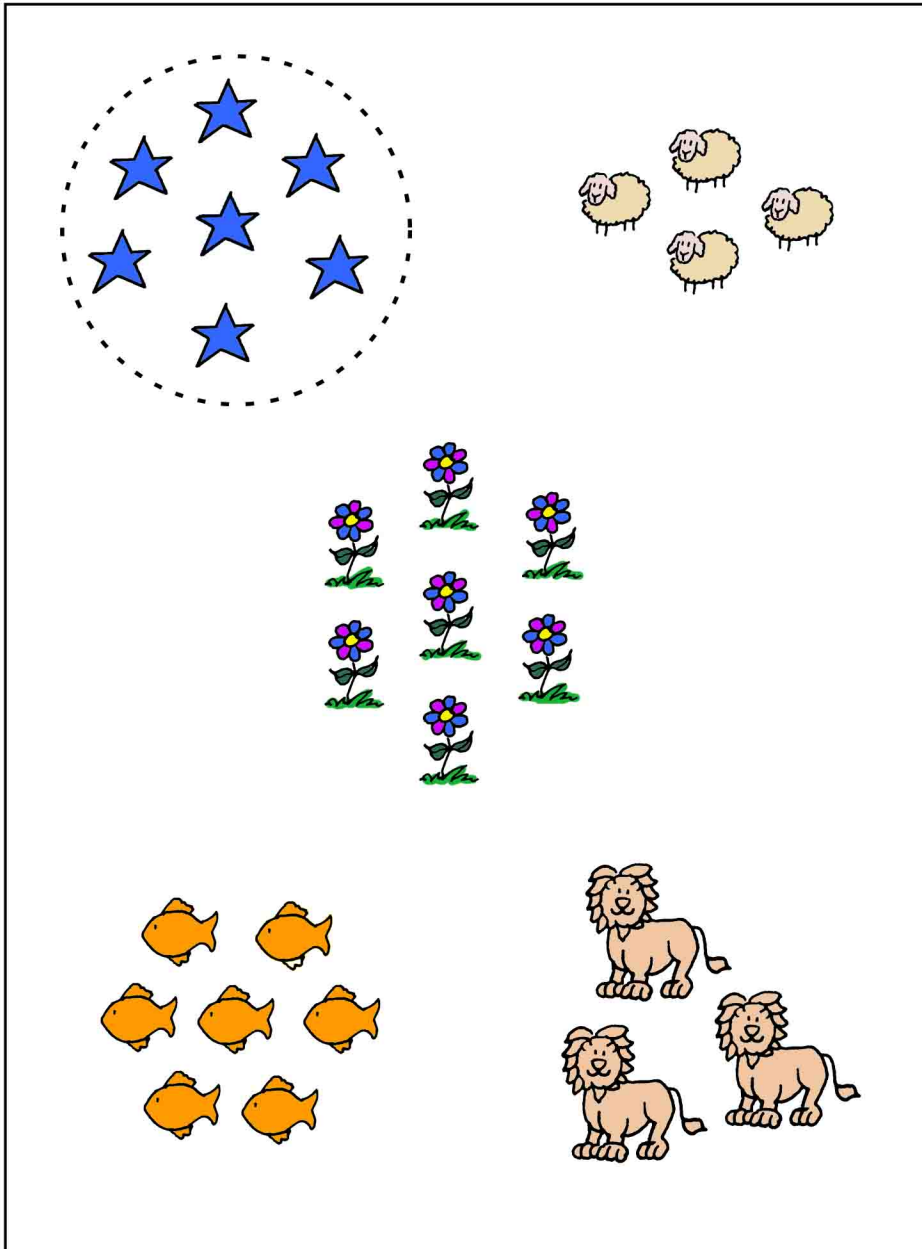

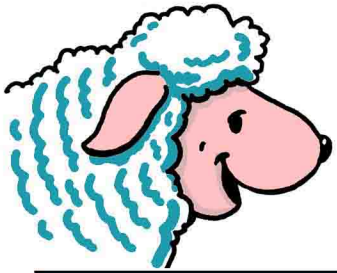
