This very day I will **give** the carcasses of the **Philistine army** to the **birds** and the **wild animals**, and the whole world will **know** that there is a God in **Israel**. All those gathered **here** will **know** that it is not by **sword** or **spear** that the **LORD** saves; for the **battle** is the **LORD's**, and he will **give** all of you into our **hands**." As the **Philistine** moved **closer** to attack him, **David** ran quickly toward the **battle** line to meet him. Reaching into his bag and taking out a **stone**, he slung it and **struck** the **Philistine** on the **forehead**. The **stone** sank into his **forehead**, and he fell facedown on the ground. So **David** triumphed over the **Philistine** with a **sling** and a **stone**; without a **sword** in his **hand** he **struck** down the **Philistine** and killed him.

5. When the Philistines saw that their hero was dead, they turned and ran.



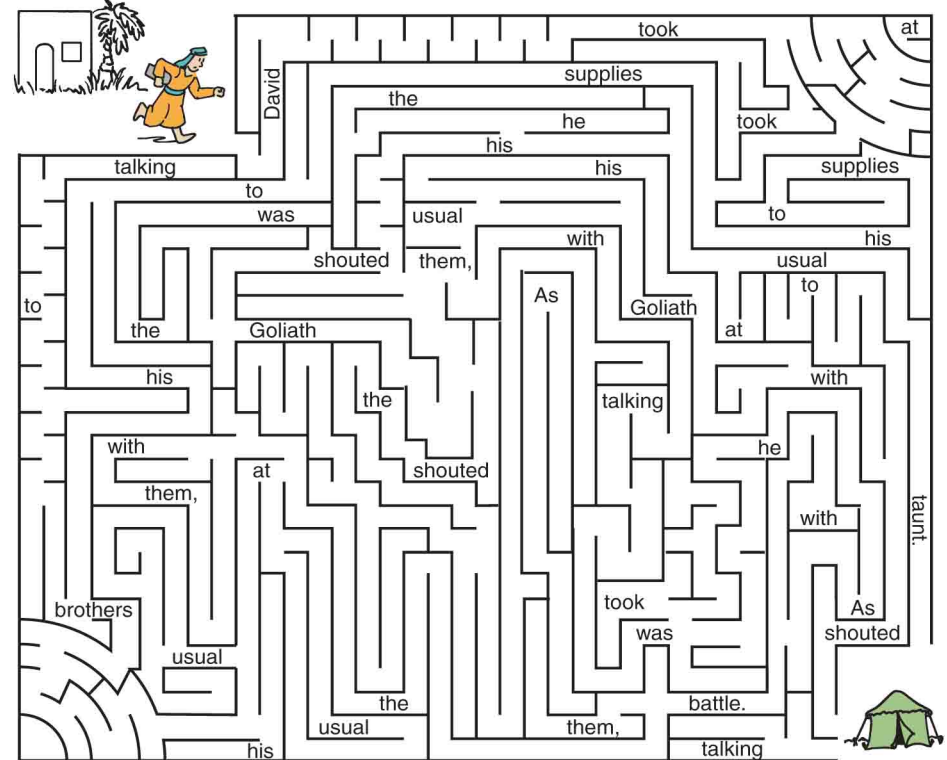
