

This day the LORD will deliver you into my hands, and I'll strike you down and cut off your head. This very day I will give the carcasses of the **Philistine army** to the **birds** and the **wild animals**, and the whole world will **know** that there is a God in **Israel**. All those gathered **here** will **know** that it is not by **sword** or **spear** that the **LORD** saves; for the **battle** is the **LORD**'s, and he will give all of you into our hands." As the Philistine moved closer to attack him, **David** ran guickly toward the **battle** line to meet him. Reaching into his bag and taking out a stone, he slung it and struck the Philistine on the forehead. The **stone** sank into his **forehead**, and he fell facedown on the ground. So David triumphed over the Philistine with a sling and a stone; without a sword in his hand he struck down the Philistine and killed him.


Draw your own pictures in each box to show what happened.

- 5. When the Philistines saw that their hero was dead, they turned and ran.




