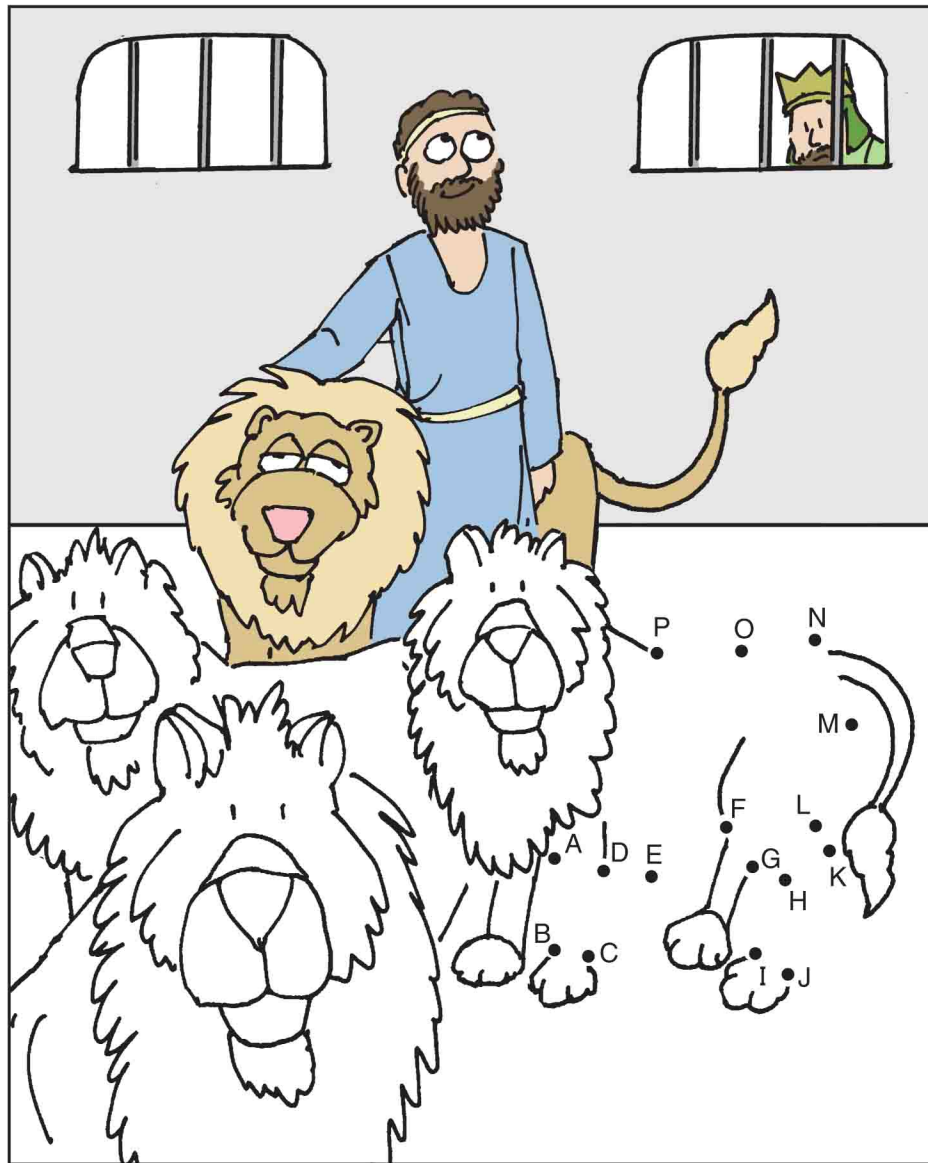

												answered, "May the king live forever! My God sent his angel, and he
												shut the mouths of the lions . They have not hurt me, because I was
												found innocent in his sight. Nor have I ever done any wrong before
												you, Your Majesty."

The next day, the king found that Daniel was alive and well. God had sent an angel to shut the mouths of the lions.

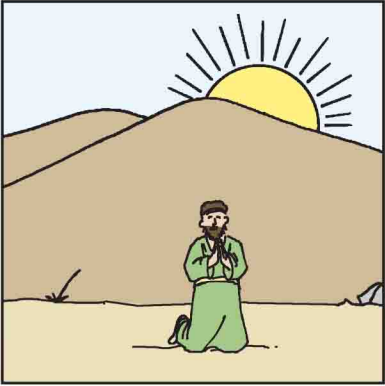

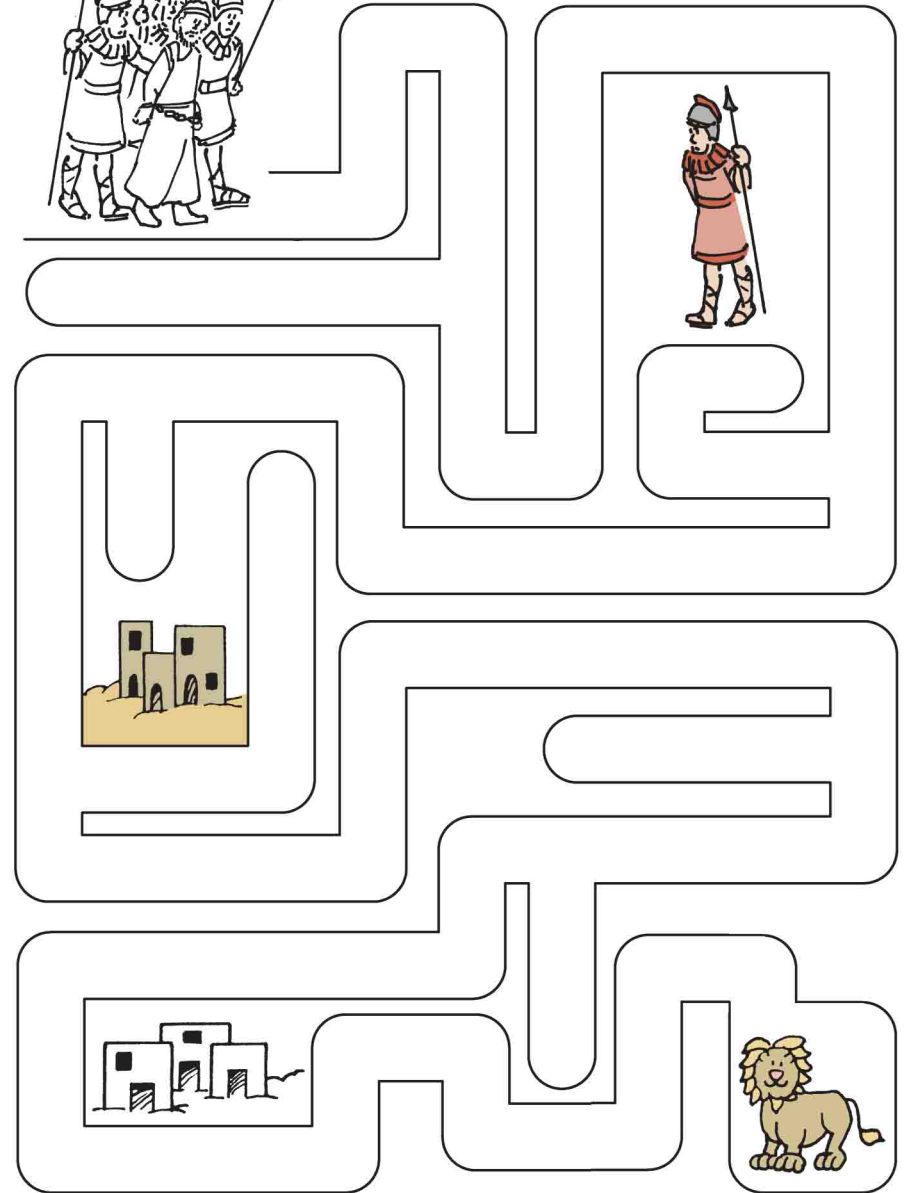
