Way! A **person's** own **folly** leads to their ruin, yet their **heart** rages against the LORD.

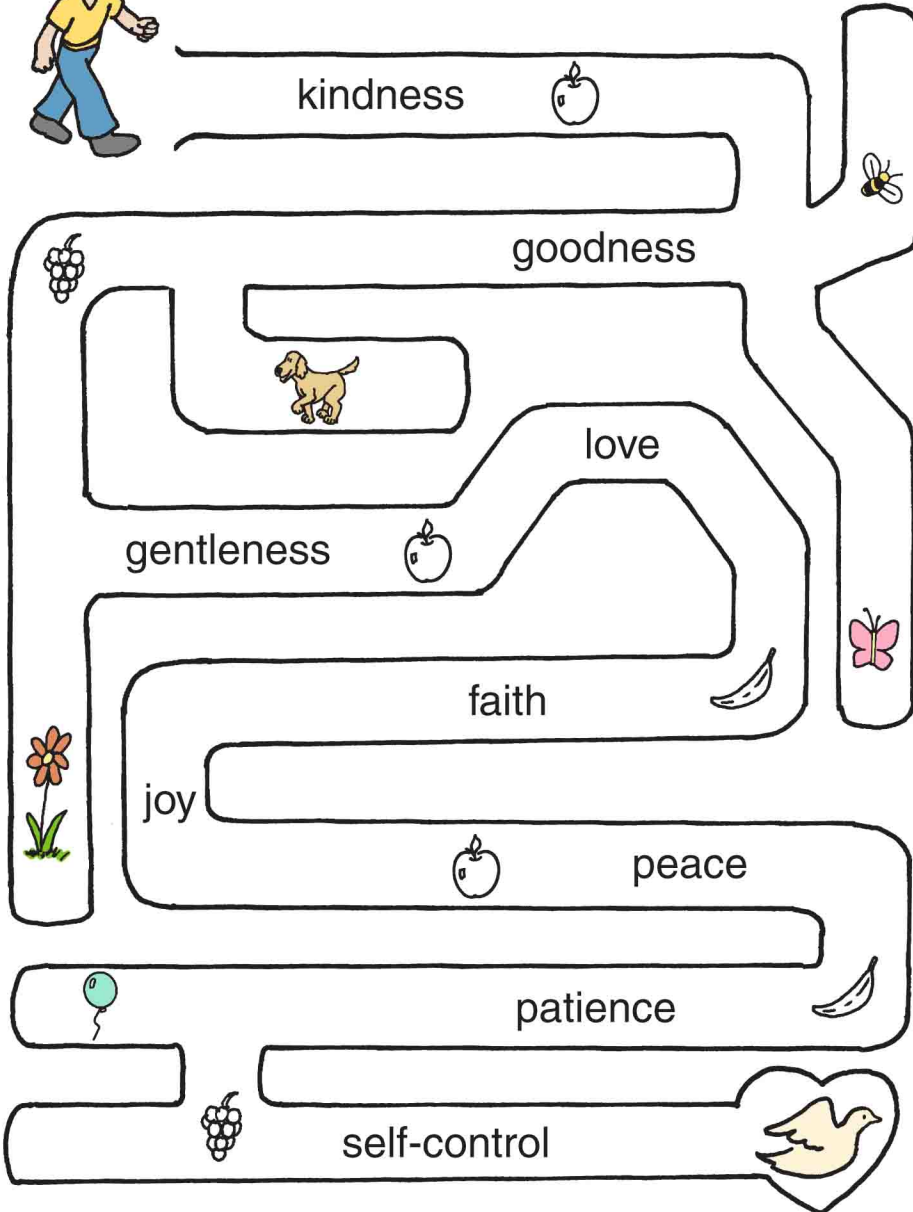

The one who gets **wisdom** loves life; the one who cherishes understanding will soon prosper. A **false witness** will not go **unpunished**, and whoever **pours** out **lies** will perish. It is not fitting for a **fool** to live in luxury— how **much** worse for a slave to rule over princes! A **person's wisdom** yields patience; it is to one's glory to overlook an offense. A king's **rage** is **like** the roar of a lion, but his **favor** is **like** dew on the grass.

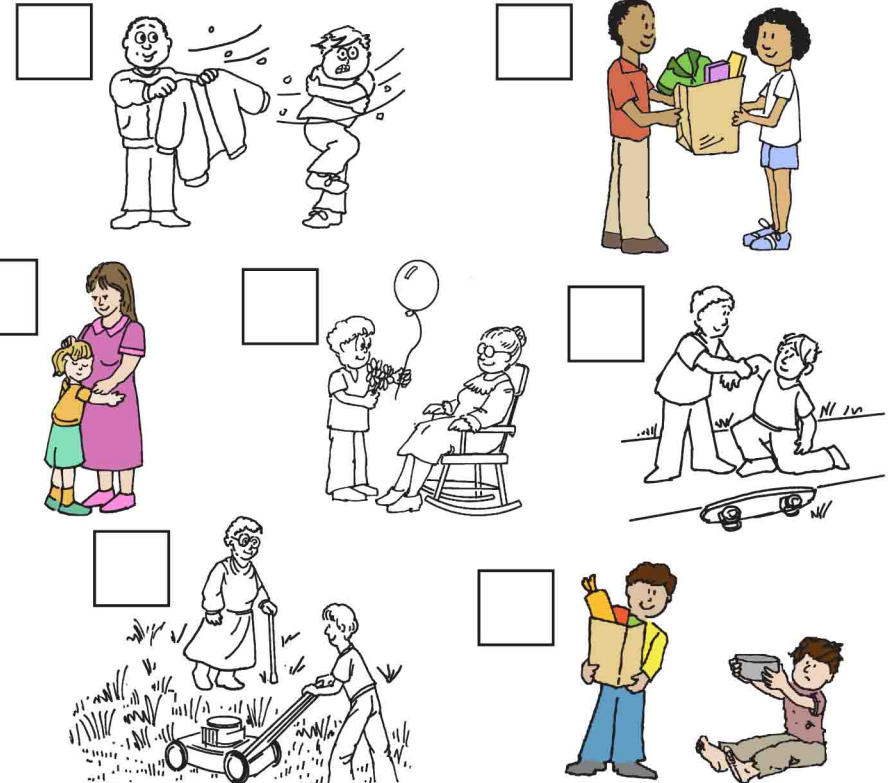

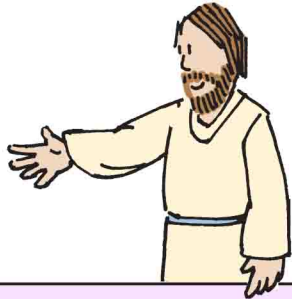

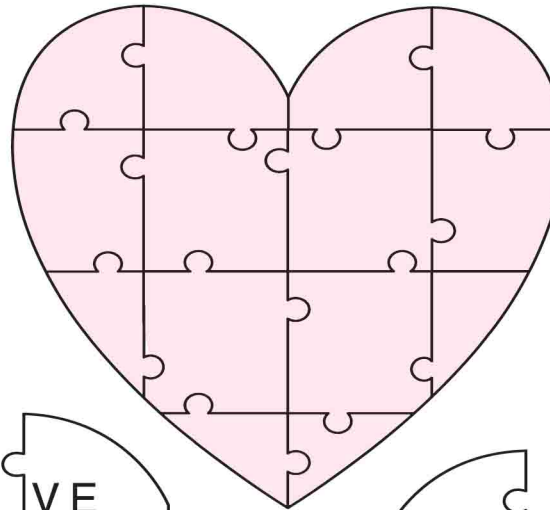
