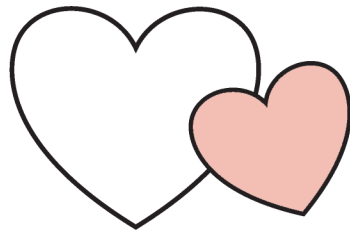
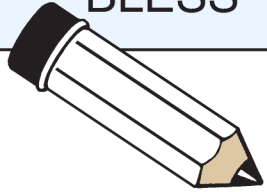

If **someone** **takes** your **coat**, do not withhold your shirt from them. **Give** to **everyone** who **asks** you, and if **anyone** **takes** what **belongs** to you, do not **demand** it **back**. Do to others as you would have them do to you. "If you **love** those who **love** you, what **credit** is that to you? **Even sinners love** those who **love** them. And if you do **good** to those who are **good** to you, what **credit** is that to you? **Even sinners** do that. And if you **lend** to those from whom you **expect** repayment, what **credit** is that to you? **Even sinners lend** to **sinners**, expecting to be repaid in **full**. But **love** your **enemies**, do **good** to them, and **lend** to them without expecting to get anything **back**. Then your reward will be great, and you will be children of the Most High, because he is kind to the ungrateful and wicked. Be **merciful**, just as your Father is **merciful**.

Jesus said, "Be merciful, just as your Father is merciful." (Mercy is a form of kindness.)
