You, **however**, must **teach** what is **appropriate** to **sound doctrine**. **Teach** the **older** men to be **temperate**, worthy of **respect**, **self-controlled**, and **sound** in **faith**, in **love** and in **endurance**. **Likewise**, **teach** the **older women** to be **reverent** in the way they **live**, not to be **slanderers** or **addicted** to **much wine**, but to **teach** what is **good**. **Then** they can **urge** the younger **women** to **love** their **husbands** and children, to be **self-controlled** and pure, to be busy at home, to be kind, and to be **subject** to their **husbands**, so that no one will malign the word of God. Similarly, encourage the young men to be **self-controlled**. In **everything** set them an example by doing what is **good**. In your teaching **show** integrity, seriousness and soundness of speech that cannot be condemned, so that those who oppose you may be ashamed because they have nothing bad to say about us. **Teach** slaves to be **subject** to their masters in **everything**, to try to please them, not to talk back to them, and not to steal from them, but to **show** that they can be fully trusted, so that in every way they will make the teaching about God our **Savior** attractive. For the grace of God has **appeared** that offers salvation to all **people**. It teaches us to say "No" to ungodliness and worldly passions, and to **live self-controlled**, upright and godly lives in this present age, while we wait for the blessed hope—the appearing of the glory of our great God and **Savior**, Jesus Christ, who gave himself for us to redeem us from all wickedness and to purify for himself a **people** that are his very own, eager to do what is **good**.

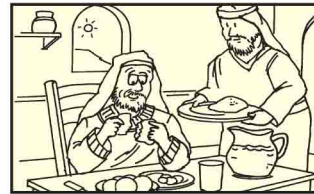
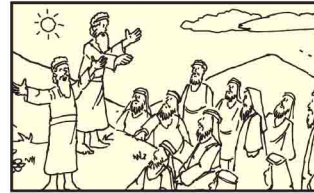
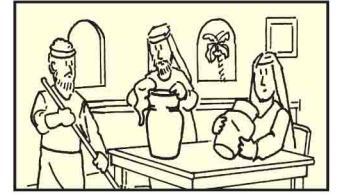

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Titus set a good example by teaching what was good.

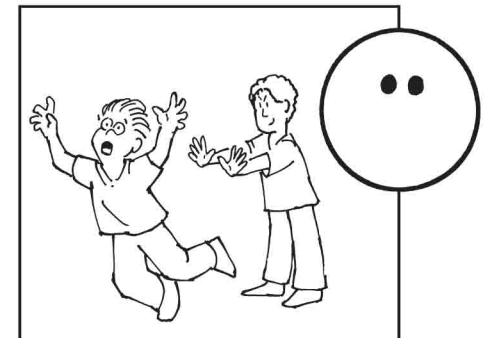
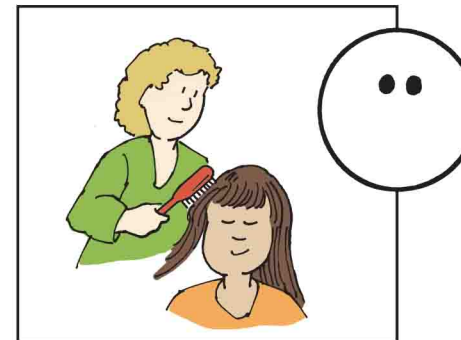
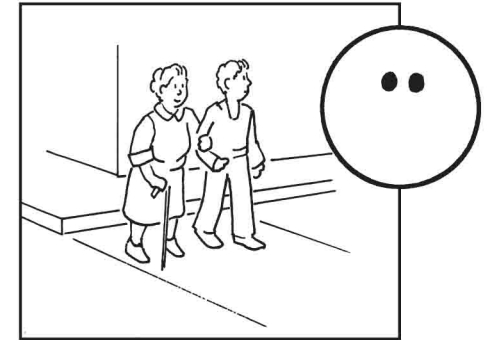
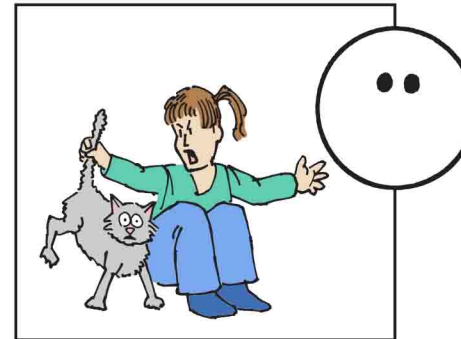
