**Today's Bible Passage: Luke 11:1-13**

S E E K K B R E A D I T One day **Jesus** was praying in a **certain** place. **When he finished**, one of his **disciples** said to him, "Lord, teach us to **pray**, just as John taught his **disciples**." He **said** to them, "**When you pray**, say: " **Father**, hallowed be your name, your kingdom **come**. **Give** us each day our daily **bread**. **Forgive** us our **sins**, for we also **forgive everyone** who **sins** against us. And lead us not into temptation.' " **Then Jesus said** to them, "**Suppose** you have a **friend**, and you go to him at midnight and say, '**Friend**, lend me three loaves of **bread**; a **friend** of mine on a journey has **come** to me, and I have no food to offer him.' And **suppose** the one inside answers, 'Don't bother me. The **door** is already locked, and my **children** and I are in bed. I can't get up and **give** you anything.' I tell you, even **though** he will not get up and **give** you the **bread because** of friendship, yet **because** of your shameless audacity he will surely get up and **give** you as **much** as you need. "So I say to you: Ask and it will be given to you; **seek** and you will **find**; **knock** and the **door** will be **opened** to you. For **everyone** who asks receives; the one who seeks finds; and to the one who knocks, the **door** will be **opened**. "Which of you fathers, if your son asks for a fish, will **give** him a snake instead? Or if he asks for an egg, will **give** him a scorpion? If you **then**, **though** you are evil, know how to **give** good gifts to your **children**, how **much** more will your **Father** in heaven **give** the Holy Spirit to those who ask him!"

Our Father knows what we need. God will give to those who ask, seek and knock.

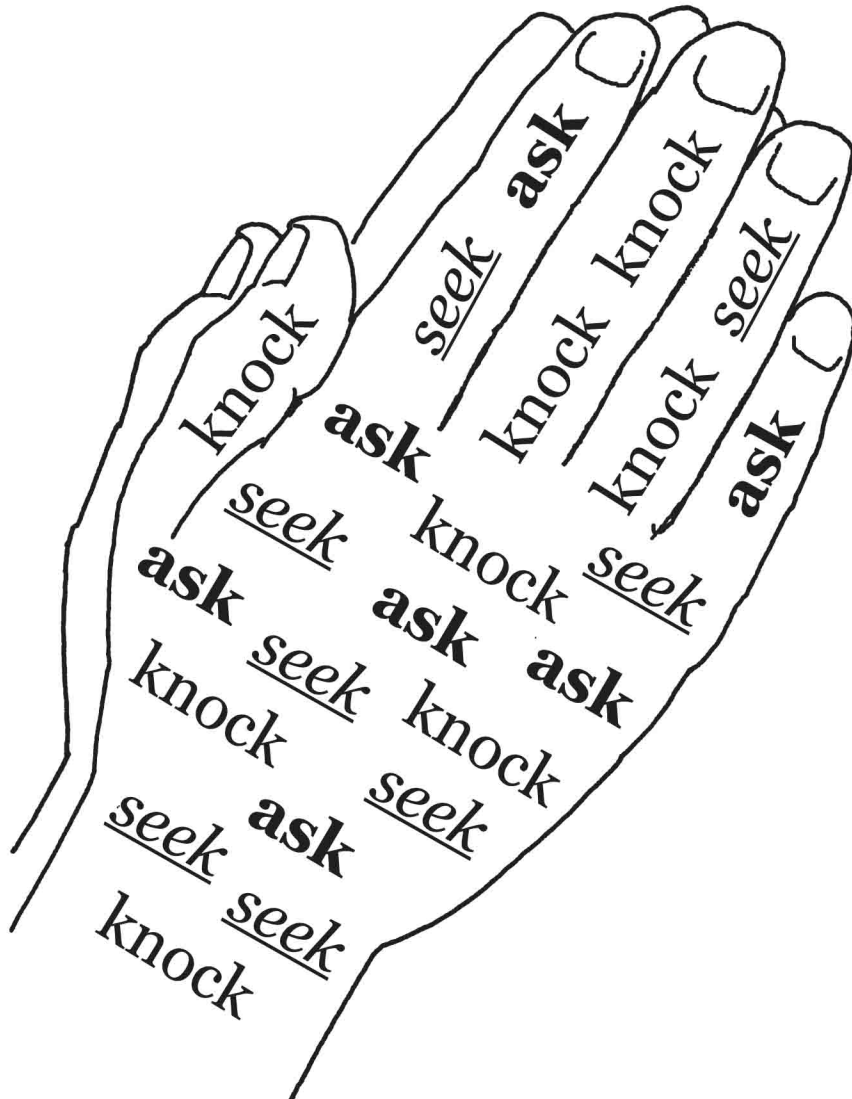
