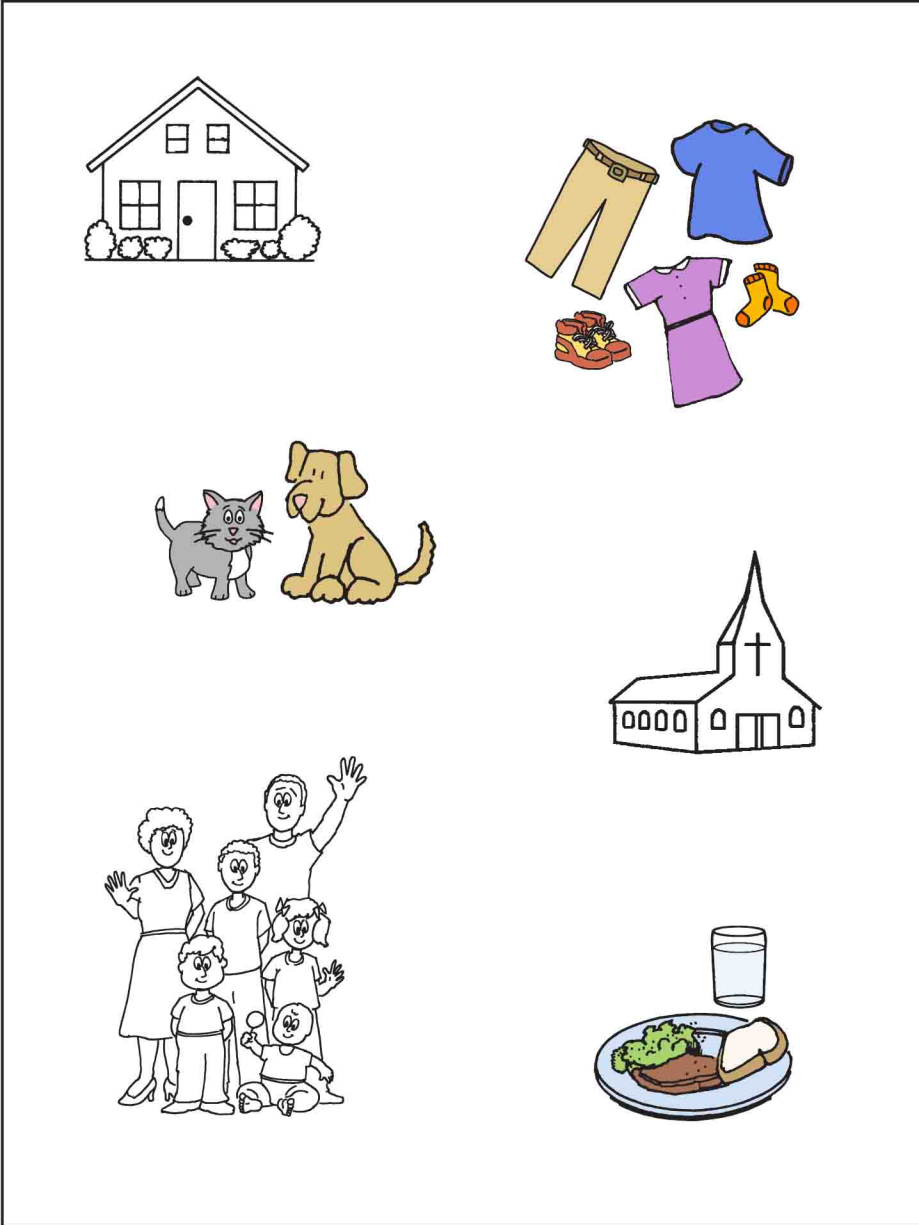

LORD your God **disciplines** you. **Observe** the commands of the **LORD** your
 God, walking in obedience to him and revering him. For the **LORD** your God
 is bringing you into a **good land**—a **land** with brooks, streams, and deep
 springs gushing out into the valleys and **hills**; a **land** with wheat and barley,
 vines and fig trees, pomegranates, olive oil and honey; a **land** where **bread**
 will not be scarce and you will lack nothing; a **land** where the rocks are iron
 and you can dig copper out of the **hills**. When you have eaten and are
 satisfied, praise the **LORD** your God for the **good land** he has given you. Be
careful that you do not forget the **LORD** your God, failing to **observe** his
 commands, his laws and his decrees that I am **giving** you this day.

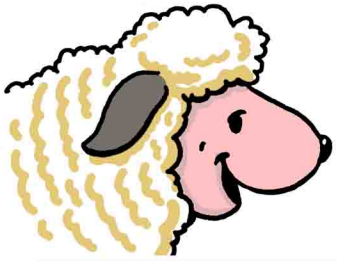

Lead the people through the maze and read the Lord's words.



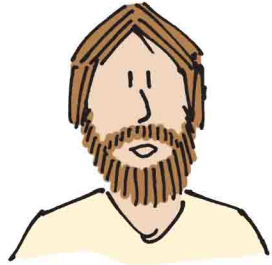

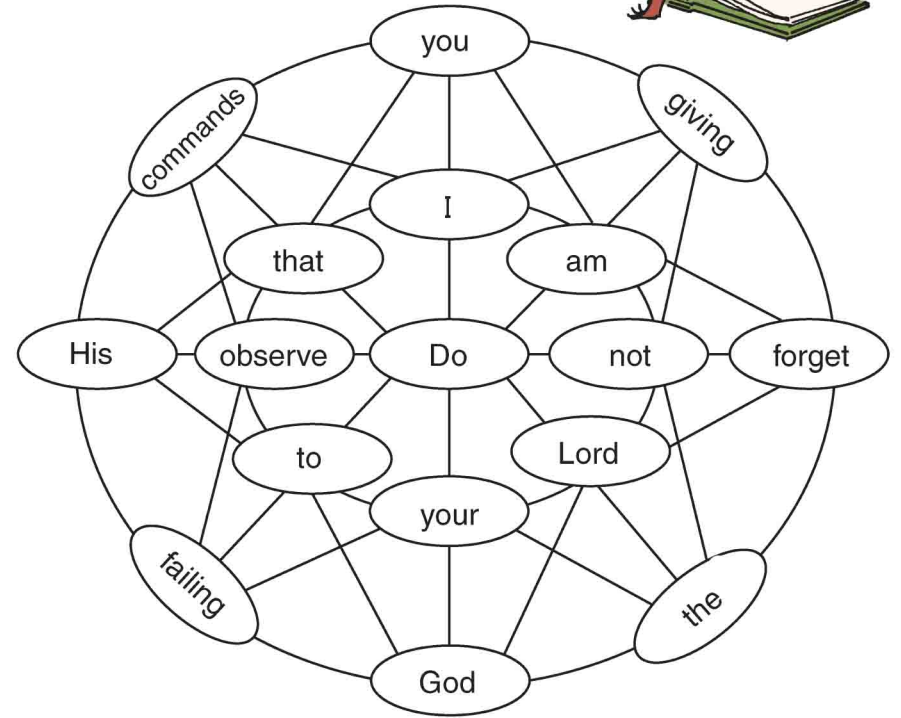
