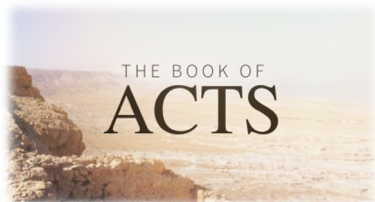

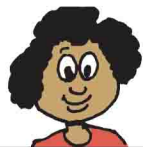

right. You **know** the **message** God sent to the **people** of **Israel**, **announcing** the **good news** of **peace** through **Jesus Christ**, who is **Lord** of all. You **know** what has **happened** throughout the province of Judea, beginning in Galilee after the baptism that John preached—how God anointed **Jesus** of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and **power**, and how he went around doing **good** and healing all who were under the **power** of the devil, because God was with him. "We are **witnesses** of everything he did in the country of the Jews and in Jerusalem. They killed him by hanging him on a cross, but God raised him from the **dead** on the third day and caused him to be **seen**. He was not **seen** by all the **people**, but by **witnesses** whom God had already chosen—by us who ate and drank with him after he rose from the **dead**. He commanded us to **preach** to the **people** and to **testify** that he is the one whom God appointed as judge of the living and the **dead**. All the prophets **testify** about him that everyone who believes in him receives forgiveness of sins through his name."

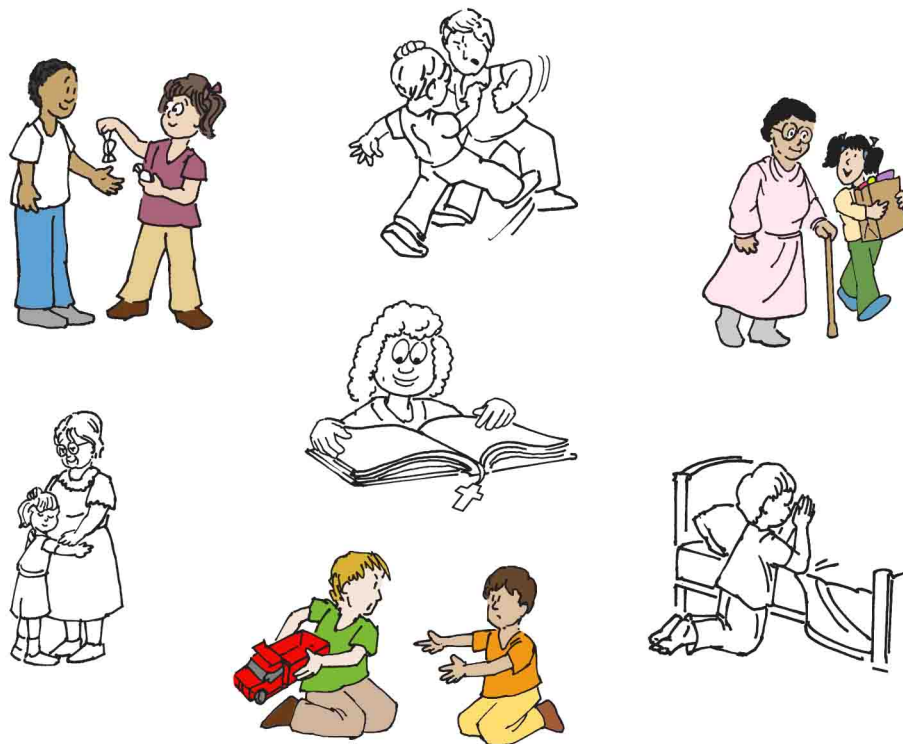

Circle the people who are trying to do the right thing.



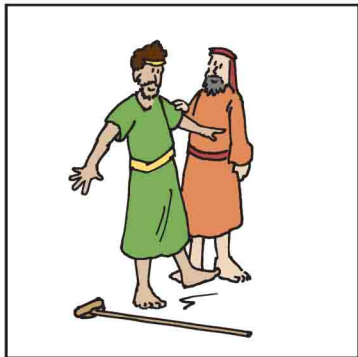
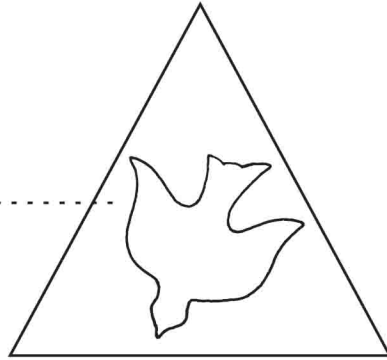
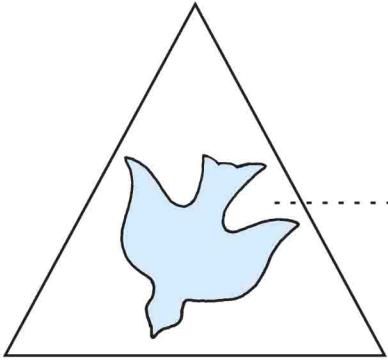

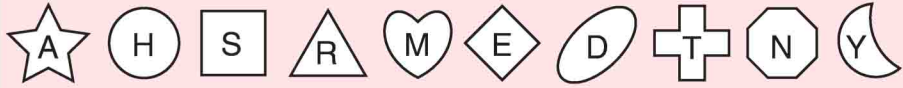
