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

They covet fields and seize them, and houses, and **take** them. They defraud people of their homes, they rob them of their inheritance. Therefore, the LORD says: "I am planning disaster against this people, from which you cannot save yourselves. You will no longer walk proudly, for it will be a



He takes it from me! He assigns our fields to traitors." " Therefore you will have no one in the assembly of the LORD to divide the land by lot. "Do not prophesy," their prophets say. "Do not prophesy about these things; disgrace will not overtake us." You descendants of Jacob, should it be said, "Does the LORD become impatient? Does he do such things?" "Do not my words do good to the one whose ways are upright? Lately my **people** have risen up like an enemy. You strip off the rich robe from those who **pass** by without a care, **like** men returning from battle. You drive the women of my **people** from their pleasant homes. You take away my blessing from their children forever. Get up, go **away**! For this is not your resting **place**, **because** it is defiled, it is ruined, beyond all remedy. If a liar and deceiver comes and says, 'I will **prophesy** for you plenty of wine and beer,' that would be just the **prophet** for this people! "I will surely gather all of you, Jacob; I will surely bring together the remnant of Israel. I will bring them together like sheep in a pen, like a flock in its pasture; the **place** will throng with **people**. The One who breaks open the way will go up before them; they will **break** through the gate and go out. Their King will pass through before them, the LORD at their head."

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







John told the people to repent.



6 differences in the 2nd picture.








The word of God came to John in the desert.
