badly.' Now please **forgive** the **sins** of the servants of the God of your **father**." **When** their message **came** to him, **Joseph** wept. His **brothers then came** and threw themselves down before him. "We are your slaves," they **said**. But **Joseph said** to them, "Don't be **afraid**. Am I in the **place** of God? You **intended** to harm me, but God **intended** it for good to accomplish what is now being done, the saving of many **lives**. So **then**, don't be **afraid**. I will provide for you and your **children**." And he reassured them and spoke kindly to them. **Joseph** stayed in **Egypt**, along with all his **father's** family. He **lived a hundred** and ten years and saw the third generation of Ephraim's **children**. Also the **children** of Makir son of Manasseh were placed at birth on **Joseph's** knees. **Then Joseph said** to his **brothers**, "I am about to die. But God will **surely come** to your aid and take you up out of this **land** to the **land** he promised on **oath** to Abraham, Isaac and Jacob." And **Joseph** made the Israelites swear an **oath** and **said**, "God will **surely come** to your aid, and **then** you must carry my bones up from this **place**."
