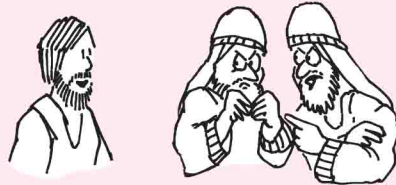

One **Sabbath** **Jesus** was **going** through the **grainfields**, and his **disciples** **began** to pick **some heads** of **grain**, rub them in their hands and eat the **kernels**. **Some** of the **Pharisees** asked, "Why are you **doing** what is unlawful on the **Sabbath**?" **Jesus** answered them, "Have you **never** read what **David** did

when he and his **companions** were **hungry**? He **entered** the **house** of God, and taking the consecrated bread, he ate what is lawful only for priests to eat. And he also gave **some** to his **companions**." **Then Jesus said** to them, "The Son of Man is Lord of the **Sabbath**." On **another Sabbath** he went into the synagogue and was teaching, and a man was **there** whose right **hand** was **shriveled**. The **Pharisees** and the **teachers** of the law were looking for a reason to accuse **Jesus**, so they watched him closely to see if he would heal on the **Sabbath**. But **Jesus** knew what they were thinking and **said** to the man with the **shriveled hand**, "Get up and stand in front of everyone." So he got up and stood **there**. **Then Jesus said** to them, "I ask you, which is lawful on the **Sabbath**: to **do** good or to **do** evil, to save life or to destroy it?" He **looked** around at them all, and **then said** to the man, "Stretch out your **hand**." He did so, and his **hand** was completely restored. But the **Pharisees** and the **teachers** of the law were furious and **began** to discuss with one **another** what they might **do** to **Jesus**.

The Pharisees went to plan how they could kill Jesus.

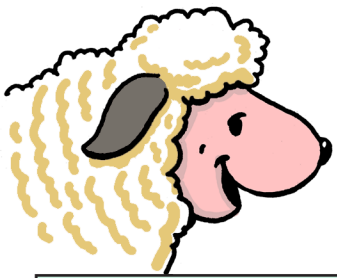
