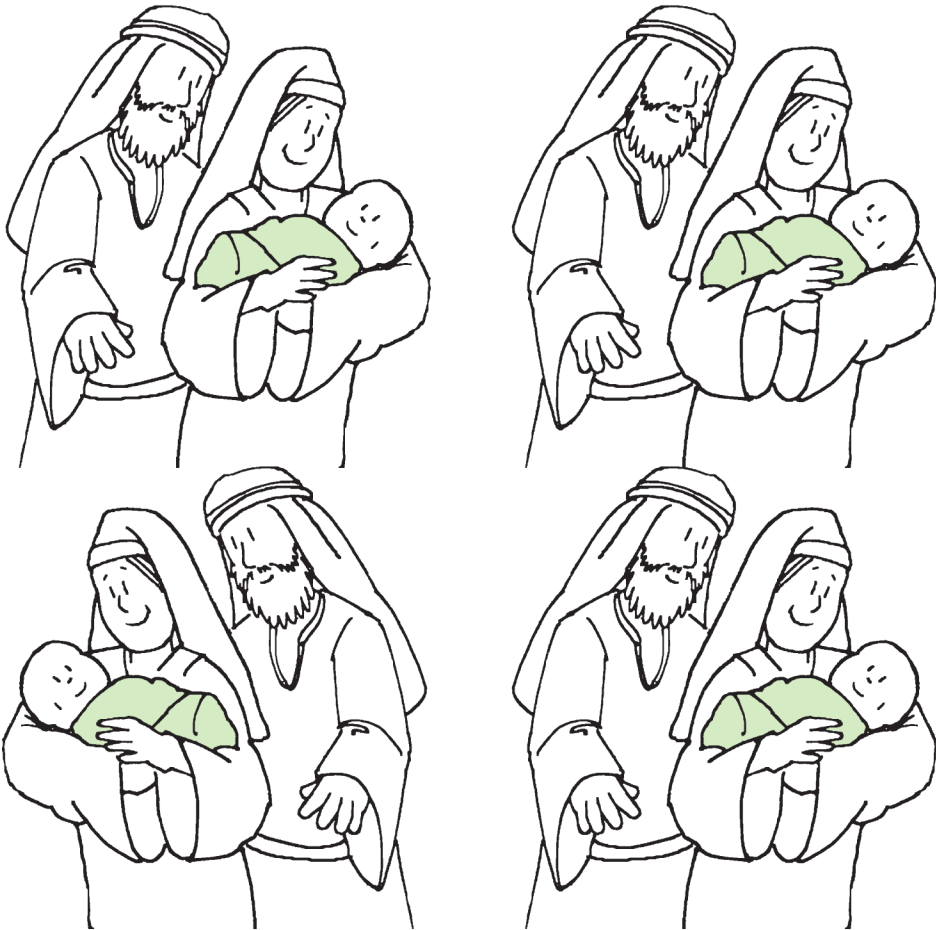

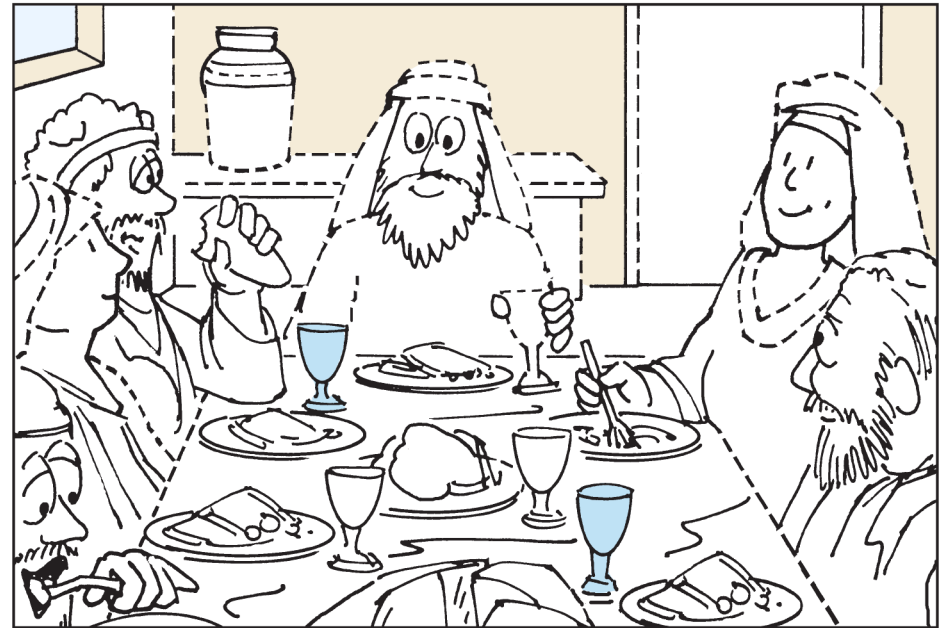


So in the course of time Hannah ... gave

and to all her sons and daughters.




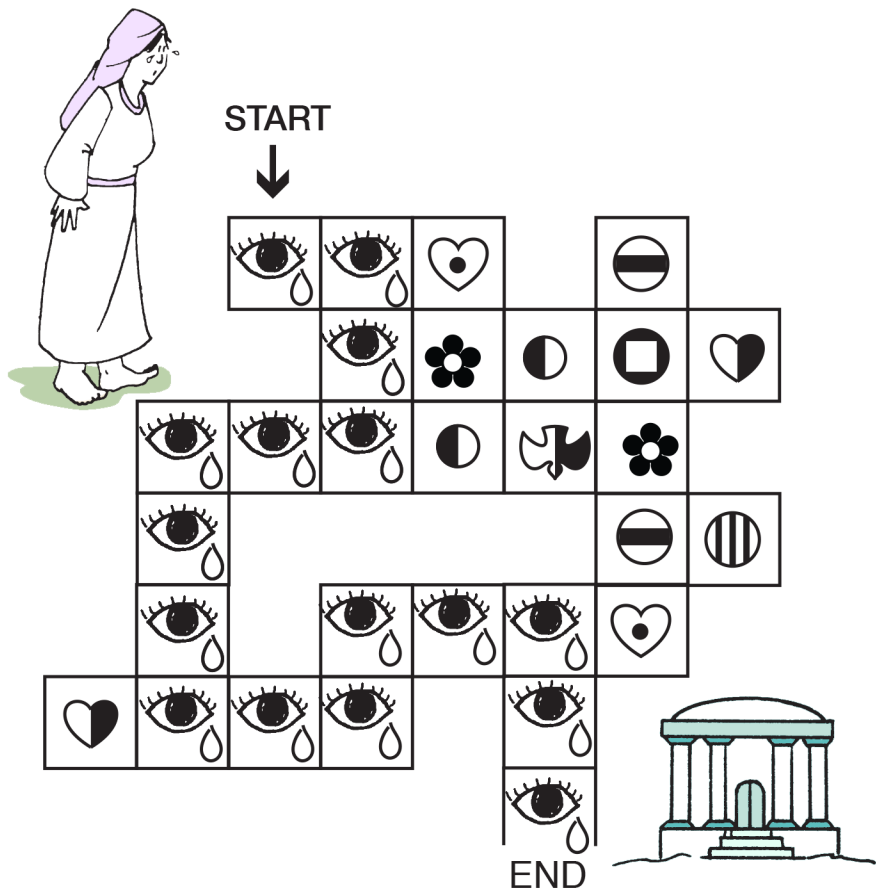
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But to his 2nd wife, Hannah, he gave more because he loved her, and she could not have children. The 1st wife, Peninnah, kept teasing Hannah to upset her.

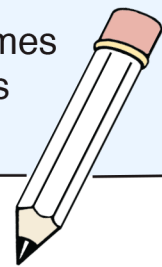

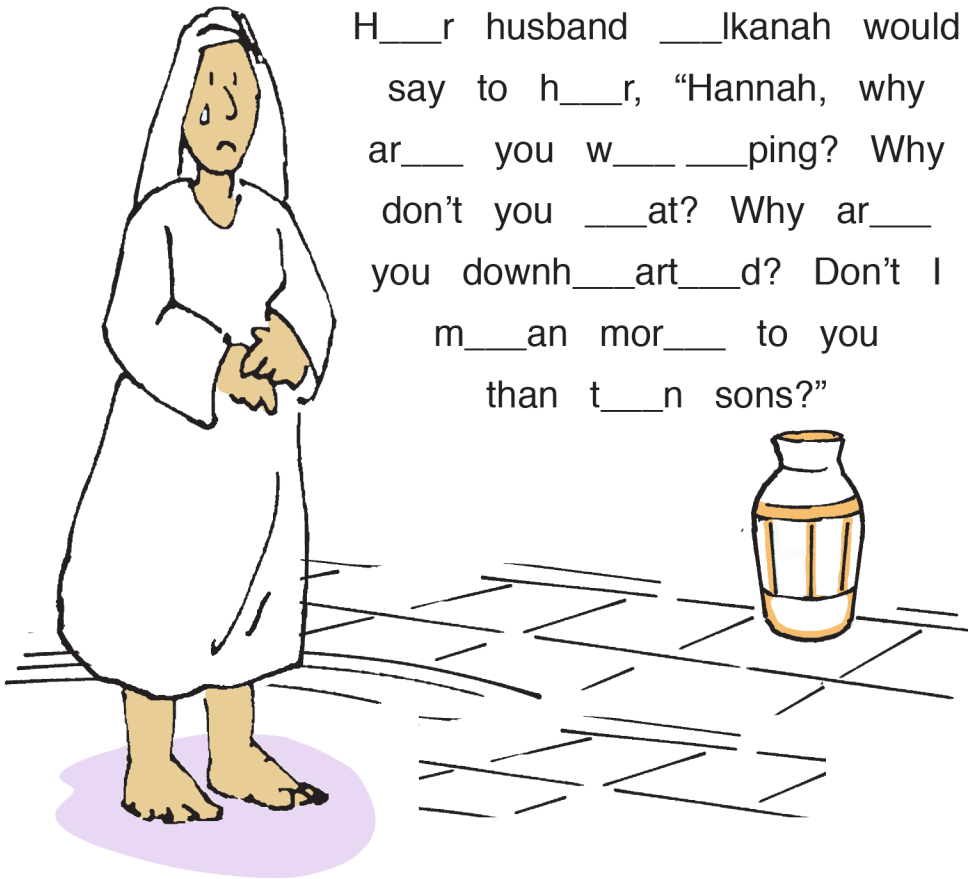

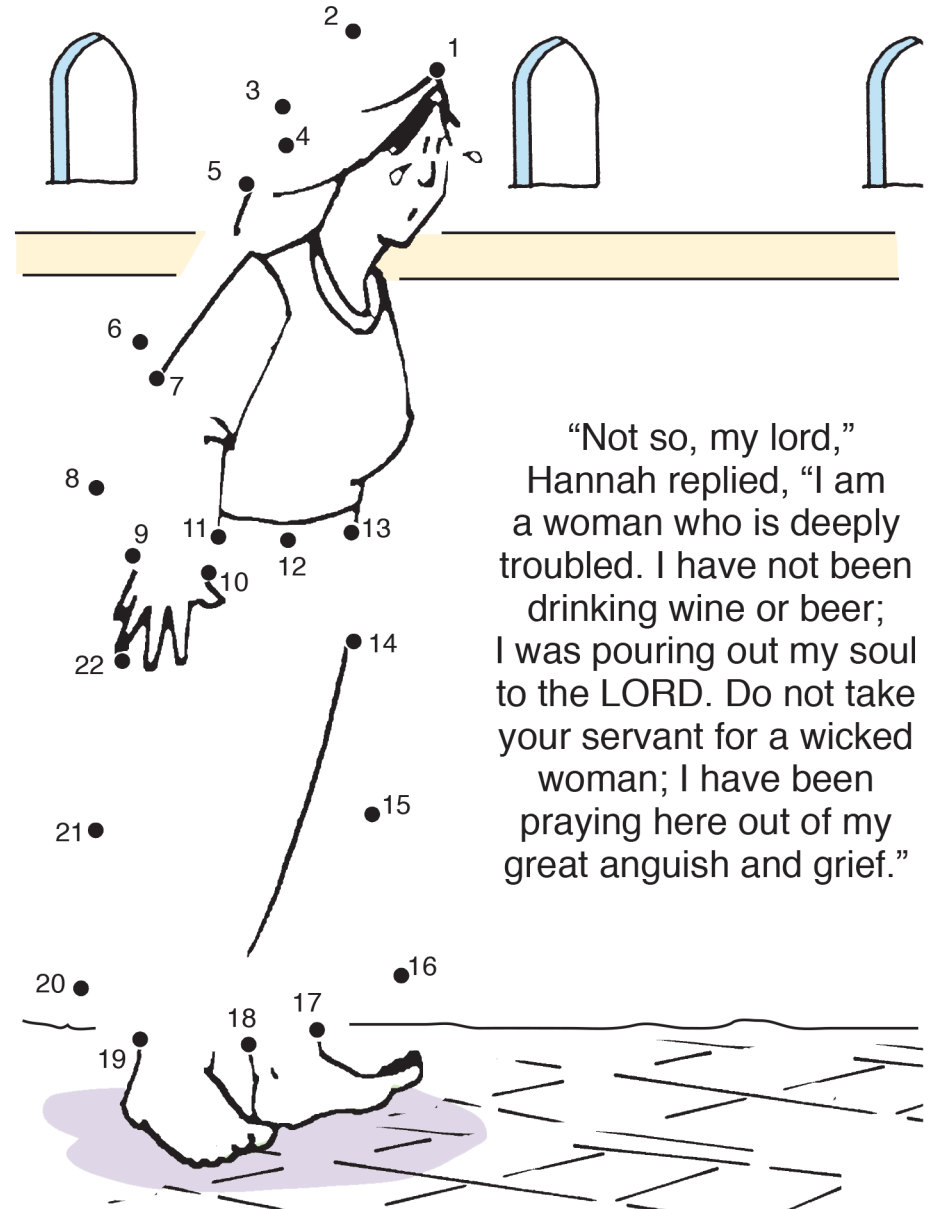
