


So Joshua called together the twelve men he had appointed from the Israelites, one from each tribe, and said to them, "Go over before the ark of the LORD your God into the middle of the Jordan. Each of you is to take up a stone on his shoulder, according to the number of the tribes of the Israelites, to serve as a sign among you. In the future, when your children ask you, 'What do these stones mean?' tell them that the flow of the Jordan was cut off before the ark of the **covenant** of the **LORD**. When it crossed the Jordan, the waters of the Jordan were cut off. These stones are to be a memorial to the people of Israel forever." So the Israelites did as Joshua commanded them. They took **twelve** stones from the **middle** of the **Jordan**, according to the number of the tribes of the Israelites, as the LORD had told **Joshua**; and they carried them over with them to their camp, where they put them down. Joshua set up the twelve stones that had been in the **middle** of the **Jordan** at the spot where the **priests** who carried the ark of the **covenant** had stood. And they are there to this day.


These stones were to be a memorial.








Read the passage and find the underlined words in the puzzle.



For the Lord your <u>God</u> dried up the <u>Jordan</u> before you until you had crossed <u>over</u>. The <u>Lord</u> your God did to the Jordan just what He had done to the <u>Red</u> Sea when He <u>dried</u> it up before us <u>until</u> we had crossed over. These <u>stones</u> are to be a <u>memorial</u> to the <u>people</u> of Israel <u>forever</u>."
