There are times when we say the phrase "this too shall pass" to encourage ourselves or others to persevere in difficult places. Yet, there are some difficult places physically, emotionally, relationally that do not pass; they last. K.J. Ramsey, author of the book, This Too Shall Last, writing from her own experience of living with chronic pain writes, "I'm well aware that some diseases aren't healed. Some hard things stay in our lives until Jesus returns, so I'm here to tell a story from the middle, where so many of us live yet so few describe (p. 19). In these pages is my outstretched hand. Instead of claiming to have solutions, I'm inviting you to sit in the place where I've found sustaining grace." (p. 23)
