
Then Moses summoned all the elders of Israel and said to them, "Go at once and select the animals for your families and slaughter the Passover lamb. Take a **bunch** of hyssop, dip it into the **blood** in the basin and put some of the blood on the top and on both **sides** of the doorframe. None of you shall go out of the door of your house until morning. When

the LORD goes through the land to strike down the Egyptians, he will see the **blood** on the top and **sides** of the **doorframe** and will **pass** over that doorway, and he will not permit the destroyer to enter your houses and strike you down. "Obey these instructions as a lasting ordinance for you and your descendants. When you enter the land that the LORD will give you as he promised, observe this **ceremony**. And **when** your children ask you, 'What does this ceremony mean to you?' then tell them, 'It is the Passover sacrifice to the LORD, who passed over the houses of the Israelites in Egypt and spared our homes when he struck down the Egyptians.' " Then the people bowed down and worshiped. The Israelites did just what the LORD commanded Moses and Aaron. At midnight the LORD struck down all the firstborn in Egypt, from the firstborn of Pharaoh, who sat on the throne, to the firstborn of the prisoner, who was in the dungeon, and the firstborn of all the livestock as well. **Pharaoh** and all his officials and all the **Egyptians** got up during the night, and there was loud wailing in Egypt, for there was not a **house** without someone dead.

Pharaoh did refuse to listen. Moses got angry and left.

Circle the picture of nighttime.






