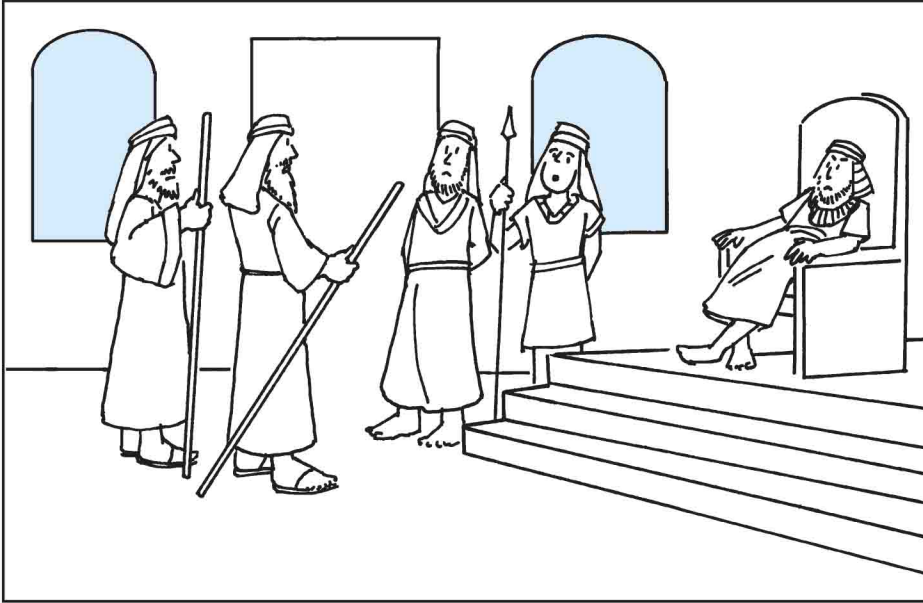

**Then Moses** summoned all the **elders of Israel** and said to them, "Go at once and select the **animals** for your **families** and slaughter the **Passover lamb**. Take a **bunch of hyssop**, dip it into the **blood** in the basin and put some of the **blood** on the top and on both **sides** of the **doorframe**. None of you shall go out of the door of your **house** until morning. **When**

the **LORD** goes through the **land** to **strike** down the **Egyptians**, he will see the **blood** on the top and **sides** of the **doorframe** and will **pass** over that doorway, and he will not permit the destroyer to **enter** your houses and **strike** you down. "Obey these instructions as a lasting ordinance for you and your descendants. **When** you **enter** the **land** that the **LORD** will give you as he promised, observe this **ceremony**. And **when** your children ask you, 'What does this **ceremony** mean to you?' **then** tell them, 'It is the **Passover** sacrifice to the **LORD**, who passed over the houses of the **Israelites** in **Egypt** and spared our homes **when** he **struck** down the **Egyptians**.'" **Then** the people bowed down and worshiped. The **Israelites** did just what the **LORD** commanded **Moses** and Aaron. At midnight the **LORD** **struck** down all the **firstborn** in **Egypt**, from the **firstborn** of **Pharaoh**, who sat on the throne, to the **firstborn** of the prisoner, who was in the dungeon, and the **firstborn** of all the livestock as well. **Pharaoh** and all his officials and all the **Egyptians** got up during the night, and **there** was loud wailing in **Egypt**, for **there** was not a **house** without someone dead.

Pharaoh did refuse to listen.  
Moses got angry and left.
